KIT LIST:

- Sleeping bag and a pillow ESSENTIAL
- Packed lunch and drink for Friday
- Waterproof jacket and if possible waterproof trousers
- Warm clothes (layers are better than thick jumpers) it could be cold on the beach and over the headland at Lulworth cove.
- Sturdy outdoor shoes/boots that you don't mind getting muddy or wet. We will be walking over the headland at Lulworth and you will need to be comfortable.
- Day bag you will need a small rucksack (not a handbag!!) to use during the day to keep your packed lunch and waterproofs in.
- Consider lining your Day bag with a plastic bag to avoid the contents getting wet if it rains a lot.
- Indoor trainers/shoes so that you can change out of muddy/wet ones.
- Towel
- Nightwear
- Toiletries
- Water bottle
- Pen/pencil
- Notebook
- Chargers for phone etc.
- Sunblock and sunhat

You will need to pack everything into one holdall/small case/rucksack to be placed in the bottom of the coach. You must be able to carry your own bag. You will not be able to access your overnight bag until Friday after 4pm so please have everything you need for the fieldwork on Friday in your day bag. If you take a phone or similar, you will need to look after it and take full responsibility for it. PGL cannot take responsibility for valuables.
