We are running **Calling it Out** in schools in Gloucestershire because we want you to be safe and happy and able to recognise unhealthy relationships.

Calling it Out reinforces to students the vital message of non-tolerance of harmful sexual behaviour. The performance and discussion-based workshop explore where these behaviours are coming from and alternative positive behaviours. The programme raises the groups' awareness of the huge impacts these everyday incidences of sexual harassment and assault can have on girls and young women and how we all have a role in safely challenging and reporting these behaviours.

Have you been affected by the performance?

Are you worried about sexual harassment and sexual abuse?

Do you think that you or someone else might be at risk?

If your answer to any of the above questions is Yes, you need to ask for help - turn over for what to do next.
