## Dear Parent/Carer

In the past, Thomas Keble School has organised an annual sponsored walk as its principal charity work. The walk has raised a tremendous amount of money, averaging over £10,000 each year and a wide variety of local, national and international causes have benefited from the students' efforts.

This year we will be supporting the following charities:

- Ex-TK student Megan Shepherd's campaign for her daughter Alba's fight against Rett Syndrome Fundraiser by Megan Shepherd : Alba's fight against Rett Syndrome (gofundme.com)
- Thomas Keble PTA Fundraising Campaign to supplement items for the new build.

Each charity will receive a third of the total funds raised.

The walk takes place entirely in the school day, this year on **Friday 29th September**. It follows an established route that is closely marshalled by a combination of parents and school staff. Each year we are indebted to those parents who volunteer to help marshal the walk. If you are able to assist at any time between 12.45pm and 2.45pm on the day we'd appreciate your help! Marshalling normally involves being visible at a fixed point on the route to assist staff in directing the students or assisting with road crossing etc. If you are able to assist on the day, please indicate this on the Microsoft Form link found later in this letter.

School uniform is not worn on the day, however sensible clothing and footwear are essential for an enjoyable walk. Please take note of the likely weather so children are properly protected from the heat and/or rain. We insist on exemplary behaviour, both as a reflection of the school, and your children, as well as a Health & Safety measure.

In order to support the smooth administration of the walk, the following action is required:
