Year 7 Science Assessment

I am writing to inform you that your child has now reached the midway point of the Year 7 curriculum in Science. They will, therefore, be formally assessed to look at progress and any intervention required. This will take place during the week beginning Monday 5<sup>th</sup> February. The assessment will last an hour and will take place in their normal Science lesson times, so no other subjects will be affected. For this test your child will need to come equipped with a pen, pencil, ruler, rubber and a calculator.

Your child will be aware of the content of this examination however, I have included below a list of topics for your information, and to help you support them with their revision.

Topics

- Introduction to Science - Lab safety – Hazards and symbols  
Equipment (names and uses);
- Biology - Cells and Reproduction;
- Chemistry - Matter and Mixtures;
- Physics – Forces

Revision resources can be found on the BBC Bitesize KS3 website. Topics can be found using the following terms as search criteria:

Biology - Living Organisms and Cells;  
Chemistry – States of Matter and Separating Mixtures;  
Physics – Forces.

I have also uploaded specific revision links to Classcharts.
