In the week beginning Monday 20<sup>th</sup> May, the Year 7 exams will take place; accompanying this letter you will find a timetable of exams for the week. Students will have exams in these subjects: Citizenship, Computing, English, Geography, History, Maths, Modern Foreign Languages and Religion, Philosophy and Ethics (RPE). Science will examine in term 6 and other subjects will be assessing students in a more continuous way.

It is important students prepare thoroughly for these exams, as not only will they give teachers a summary of what students have learned, they also offer an important preparation experience for future GCSE exams.
