Network of Stroud Hubs (NoSH) Flyer: Attached for your reference.

Across Stroud, the hubs offer food provision six days a week (excluding Sundays) on a 'pay what you can, if you can' basis, including access to a food pantry that includes hygiene products.

The hubs distribute food vouchers provided by SDC, available in limited quantities, and hubs may limit the number of vouchers each guest can receive monthly to ensure fair distribution.

While not part of NoSH, Cashes Green Community Centre also offers a variety of activities and food options (their timetable is linked [here](#)).

Chapel Street Community Café Flyer: Open every Wednesday from 10.30am to 12pm at the Salvation Army on Acre Street, where guests can enjoy a hot breakfast roll, refreshments, pastries, and a variety of board games and children's toys.
