Please note:

- KS3 Core subjects – English, Maths, MFL and Science will set one task per week (MFL tasks are very short 10-minute practice tasks that on occasion may be required for the next lesson)
- KS3 non-core (not including PE) will set one task per fortnight
- Students are expected to spend up to 45 minutes working on their homework per subject
- Where the timetable allows, students will in most cases be given at least 4 days to complete all tasks.
If students reach the maximum time and have not completed the work, parents are asked to indicate this in students' books
- PHSE is taught in Terms 3, 4, 5, & 6 and doesn't set home learning. Citizenship is taught in Terms 1 & 2 with 2 or 3 tasks set during these terms.
