Regulations/Information

1. Entry is open to attendees of a Stroud & District School, members of a Stroud & District Table Tennis Club, Stroud Junior League participants and those that live in the Stroud District.
2. Players may enter a maximum of **two singles competitions plus one doubles** within the age constraints below (subject to entry level and discretion of the organiser)
3. Under 11's must be born in 2015 or later
4. Under 13's must be born in 2013 or later
5. Under 15's must be born in 2011 or later
6. Under 19's must be born in 2007 or later
7. All competitions will initially be played in groups with the group winners and group runners-up going into the knock-out rounds. (subject to entry levels)
8. All competitions will be played through to the finals and trophies/medals presented on the day.
9. Entry will be at the discretion of the Organiser.
10. Playing clothing shall normally consist of a short-sleeved shirt, shorts/track suit or skirt, and sports shoes. White or predominantly white clothing is not allowed.
11. Matches will be best of 3 or 5 games (subject to entry level), 11-up.
12. Table Tennis England registration is mandatory.

Privacy Notice or Data Protection Policy

The Stroud & District Table Tennis League will:

- Comply with the data protection laws of the UK.
- Only collect personal data (name, address, telephone numbers, email addresses and similar) for the purpose of managing The Club and its activities.
- Only use an individual's data for the purposes of The Club
- Look after the data (it is strictly confidential) and not lose it.
- Allow an individual to see the data held about them, and the League will correct it if necessary, or if requested, the league will delete the data.
- Regularly review the data held, and when no longer needed for active use the league will either delete the data or, if a record is still needed (and the individual has not requested their record to be deleted) reduce the data held to the minimum necessary.
