Dear Parents and Carers,

Following our recent assessment in mathematics, your child has been set a *Sparx Fix-Up* task. We would like to take this opportunity to explain what Sparx Fix-Up is, how students can access it, and why completing it is an important part of their learning.

What is Sparx Fix-Up?

Sparx Fix-Up is a personalised set of follow-up questions automatically generated by the Sparx Maths platform after an assessment. It identifies the specific topics or skills your child found challenging in the test and provides tailored practice to help strengthen their understanding. Every student receives a different Fix-Up task based on their individual needs.

How do students access their Fix-Up?

Students can access their Fix-Up work in exactly the same way they access their weekly Sparx homework:

1. Go to **sparxmaths.com**
2. Log in with their usual school login details
3. Click on the **Fix-Up** section that appears on their homepage
4. Work through the questions until they reach 100% completion

If students have difficulty logging in, they should speak to their Maths teacher so we can support them.

Why is completing Fix-Up important?

Fix-Up tasks are designed to:

- Close gaps identified in the assessment
- Reinforce key skills to support future learning
- Build confidence by revisiting areas students found difficult
- Ensure students are secure in the foundations needed for upcoming topics



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Completing Fix-Up work helps us ensure every child has the best possible chance to progress and succeed in maths. For many students, addressing these gaps promptly also prevents small misunderstandings from becoming bigger barriers later.

We ask that all students complete their Fix-Up on Sparx, so teachers can check their understanding and plan any additional support if needed.
